

Exhibit of the day will be a museum panel/banner in the backyard, where the visitor learns about living conditions in "Gazochori" (today Gazi). Also a photo contest is held titled "Gazi today". Applicants must register at the museum and send their photos that day. The ten (10) best will be posted on the museum's Facebook page.

As part of the actions is also included a projection video documentary on the area around the Gazi by director and local resident **Thanassis Tsaousopoulos** in the building of New Watergas. 


